 Meeting, it is no longer eligible and must be withdrawn unless you have already received prior approval. Please
 contact the RSNA Program Services Department (programs@rsna.org) immediately to discuss this matter. The RSNA
 Policy on Previously Presented or Published Abstracts requires that all scientific abstracts scheduled for
 presentation at its annual scientific assembly be original work, not previously presented at other national or
 international radiological society meetings.
